### **Recent Academy Graduations**

<u>Genesee County Sheriff's Office</u> (Submitted by Genesee CSO) Corrections Officers from Genesee County, Berrien County, Branch County, Chippewa County, Ingham County, and Sanilac County Sheriff's Office recently completed a local corrections officer training academy held at the Genesee County Sheriff's Office.

The four-week Local Corrections Officer Academy offers a comprehensive, interactive instruction program in various disciplines specific to Local Correction Officers. Training topics include custody and security, defensive tactics, first aid (including CPR and AED procedures), prisoner mental health and suicide awareness, fire safety and interpersonal communications. The Academy, certified by the Michigan Sheriffs' Coordinating and Training Council, is an important element of providing the necessary skills for maintaining a safe, secure environment for Correction Officers, inmates and county residents.

### MENTAL HEALTH FIRST AID FOR FIRST RESPONDERS/CORRECTIONS OFFERED NOVEMBER AND DECEMBER 2022

The MSCTC is excited to present the Mental Health First Aid for Public Safety (MHFA) tuition FREE\* to certified Local Corrections Officers. MHFA is an 8-hour course that teaches a 5-step action plan encompassing the skills, resources, and knowledge to help an individual in crisis connect with the appropriate professional, peer, and self-help care. MHFA for Public Safety is recognized and supported by the Michigan Mental Health Diversion Council (MMHDC), Crisis Intervention Team (CIT) of Michigan, and CIT International.
