Effective January 1, MSCTC staff will take over entering the Academy hours into LCOTS for each officer that successfully completes it. Please make sure all who has access to LCOTS knows this. Thank you. If you have any questions, please contact us!

Also, please do not use any category that has "AA" in front of it, it is for instructor use only. Thank you!

Yearly Training Hour Requirements

Just a friendly reminder as we approach the end of the year that each active officer should have at least 20 hours of in-service training entered into LCOTS. This should include:

1. At least 3 training categories
2. 2-hours of Mental Health Training
3. No more than 5-hours in firearms training

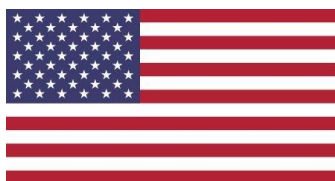
